Create a poster including what a plant needs to grow.	Choose a plant (in your house or in nature) and sketch it. Add colour to make your sketch life-like.
Write and learn the number bonds for 100 (multiples of 5). Eg. 35+ 65 = 100	Design a poster or a leaflet to persuade people to help protect the Rainforest.	Research facts about the Amazon Rainforest.	For 1 minute, how many star jumps can you do?	Create a poster teaching other children about online bullying.
Write and learn the 8 times table and the division facts.  Eg. 1 × 8 = 8  8÷ 1 = 8	Create a Rainforest habitat in a shoebox.	Draw a circus scene.	Practice your numbers in French - there are lots of songs on YouTube!	Write a persuasive letter to someone in your family.
