E.g. sharp teeth, big nose.</p> <p>Can you write a sentence about it?</p>	<p>Can you design a troll?</p> <p>Maybe you could paint it, colour it in or use recycling materials to make a model?</p>
	<p>Can you find 10 objects and separate them into 2 piles. How many different ways can you make 10? Can you record your number sentences?</p>	<p>We have been learning lots of new songs. Can you teach a member of your family one of our songs?</p> <p>E.g 'Charlie over the ocean, doggy, doggy where's my bone?'</p>	<p>Pretend you are a dinosaur explorer.</p> <p>Can you make a map for us to follow to find the dinosaurs?</p> <p>You could include trees, volcanoes, rivers, caves etc.</p>	<p>Can you design a bridge?
