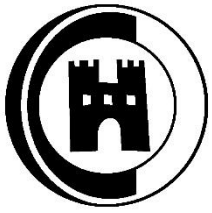


Year 3 Home Learning Grid Term 5 Our topic this term is: **Extreme Earth**

Draw a map showing where volcanoes are around the world.	Sort different animals by what they eat. Carnivore, omnivore and herbivore.	Find out about the skeletons of different animals.	Draw a picture of a volcano and label it.	Draw a picture of a human skeleton and label the bones.
Compare the weights of different food packages using the $<$, $>$ and $=$.	Find out about the after effects of a volcano.	Find out about Mount Etna. Create a fact file.	Write a book review about your favourite book.	Design a poster about healthy eating.
Find out which animals and plants live near volcanoes.	Research about an earthquake in our local area.	Investigate where the food you eat comes from.	Write a recipe for a healthy smoothie.	Make a PE circuit and record how long it takes to complete it.
