You could take a photo of your shop or draw the coins.</p>	<p>Create a poster about being safe online. Then draw the Earth and label the Arctic/Antarctic. Write something you have learned from the song.</p>	<p>Learn your number bonds to 20 by heart. Ask an adult in school to check your understanding. Use your number bonds to 10 to help e.g. $9 + 1 = 10$ So $19 + 1 = 20$</p>

Make a list of some of them and draw one or two.</p>	<p>Write numbers up to 20 and then write the words next to each one (e.g. 0-zero, 1 - one, 2 - two, 3 - three – all the way up to 20 - twenty).</p>	<p>Keep a weather diary for a week. Challenge: can you record the temperature too.</p>
	<p>Write a list of all the things you would need for a teddy bear's picnic.</p>	<p>Write at least 6 sentences that need either a question mark or an exclamation mark at the end instead of a full stop.</p>	<p>Explore the idea of weaving. What is weaving? Try to weave using paper or material of your own choice.</p>	<p>Collect leaves and identify which type of tree they are from. Stick on paper and bring to school.</p>

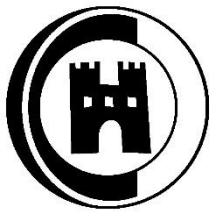
