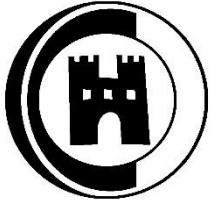


Year 2 Home Learning Grid Term 6: The Seaside

Can you find any photos of a Kent beach from the past?</p>	<p>Learn your 2 times tables. Once you have done this, ask your teacher for a verbal quiz to earn ten merits!</p>	<p>Write an acrostic poem about the seaside - use your five senses to help you.</p>	<p>Can you perform some exercises and write some adverbs to explain how you performed them. E.g. I ran <u>quickly</u> to the bus stop, I skipped <u>joyfully</u> home from school.</p>	<p>Learn your 10 times tables. Once you have done this, ask your teacher for a verbal quiz to earn ten merits!</p> <p>Challenge - learn the division facts e.g. if $10 \times 2 = 20$ then $20 \div 10 = 2$.</p>	
<p>Collect items from the beach and make a collage with them.</p>	<p>Paint or draw a picture of Folkestone harbour.</p>	<p>Write your number bonds to 100. e.g. $80 + 20 = 100$, $90 + 10 = 100$, $100 + 0 = 100$.</p>	<p>Learn your 5 times tables. Once you have done this, ask your teacher for a verbal quiz to earn ten merits!</p> <p>Challenge - learn the division facts e.g. if $5 \times 2 = 10$ then $10 \div 5 = 2$.</p>	<p>Learn your 3 times tables. Once you have done this, ask your teacher for a verbal quiz to earn ten merits!</p>	<p>Design your own bucket and spade.</p>	
<p>Write your number bonds to 100. e.g. $0 + 100 = 100$, $10 + 90 = 100$, $20 + 80 = 100$.</p>	<p>Write a setting description of the seaside.</p>	<p>Draw and label a seaside picture.</p>	<p>Write a fact file about a sea creature.</p>	<p>Write a set of instructions for building a sandcastle.</p>	<p>Make ice-cream cone cupcakes. https://sugarspunrun.com/ice-cream-cone-cupcakes/</p>
