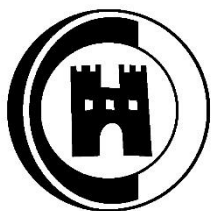


## Year 3 Home Learning Grid Term 6. Our topic this term is: **The Mighty Roman Empire**
