**Make sure you read at home every day and learn your weekly spellings.**

<p><b>Complete at least 1 activity per week and colour the activity you have done.</b></p> <p><i>Remember you can draw, write, build, collage, etc</i></p>	<p>Draw a picture of your favourite toy and write about it. Why is it your favourite?</p>	<p>How many legs are there in your house? Draw and count in twos to find the total. Record the total on your paper.</p>	<p>Talk to someone older than you about what life was like when they were a child. Ask someone to take a photo of you both. What did you talk about?</p>	<p>Make a poster showing all the different ways of making 10, eg</p>  <p>6 + 4 = 10</p>
	<p>Ask your Nanny and/or Grandad about what their favourite toy was when they were little. Write about or draw and label what they told you.</p>	<p>Learn the alphabet song and sing it to an adult in class. 	<p>Create a poster of your 5 senses.</p>	<p>Write a list of your favourite foods.            Challenge: what senses do you use when you eat?</p>	<p>Write a poem about Autumn.</p>	<p>Choose a member of your family to write a description of.</p>
	<p>Paint/make a picture of your favourite day or event in the Summer holidays. Your picture needs to show what the weather was like on that day. Where did you go? Who did you go with? What did you do?</p>	<p>Write a description of a toy. Can we guess what it is?</p>	<p>Practise counting to 20 with an adult at home. Then count to 20 to an adult in school to show your learning. Perhaps you can also try counting backwards?</p>	<p>Make a 'Smell Book'; show pictures of different smells on each page. Write if you think each smell is nice/horrible. Try to find different words that are similar to nice/horrible to describe the smells.</p>
