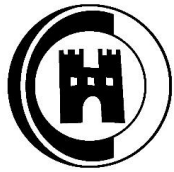


Hythe and Dymchurch (Year 1) Home Learning Grid, Term 2

Make sure you read at home at least 3 times each week and learn your weekly spellings.

Complete at least 1 activity per week and colour the activity you have done. Remember you can draw, write, build, collage, etc	Draw a map from your home to school. Can you include a key or add some labels?	What do you like and dislike about your local park? Make a list.	Can you teach your grown up how to use a part-whole model?	How long can you balance on 1 leg for? Use a timer to record this.
	Can you find items made from different materials around your house? e.g. glass, metal, wood. Draw and label pictures of these.	Create a poster about someone who is special to you.	Go on a shape hunt. What shapes can you find around your home? Draw and label them.	Can you teach your grown up one of the songs we have learnt in music?
	Can you create a daily weather diary for the week? Tell us the day and what the weather was like.	Can you write your number bonds to 10?	Write a recount of what you did at the weekend or in the October half term.	Can you draw/paint/collage a seasonal picture.
	Can you design and build a structure you would like to see on the playground? Take a photograph for us to see. Extension: Can you make a list of the materials you used.
